"Catholic Mission and Evangelism"

This is the second of our days celebrating Catholic Mission and Evangelism in the Anglican Tradition. The aim of these days is to encourage and resource churches in our dioceses for whom this is their tradition and also to welcome colleagues from other traditions to explore and enjoy Anglo-Catholic Mission, Evangelism and Worship.

These days owe their existence to The Society of St Wilfrid and Saint Hilda and in particular to their chapter in the Diocese of Durham, the Chapter of Our Lady and St Cuthbert. At their request, these days are open to Anglicans of all traditions.

The day is centred on the celebration of Mass/Eucharist at 12noon. We are delighted that Bishop Stephen, the new Bishop of Beverly will preside and preach.

Archdeacon Luke Miller will lead us in two workshops exploring both the underlying theology of Anglo-Catholic Mission and Evangelism and also how it can be lived out in practice.

To earth the day in the North East, the Revd John McManners, a well-known local writer and guide will remind us of St Aidan's life, qualities and ministry. Evangelism and Mission are not new-fangled ideas in the modern church but are deeply rooted in the Church of the North-East.
