- 6. Vision, Provision, Impact (How does the vision impact on....? Support.....?)
- 7. One overall judgement along with judgment statements on RE (VA only) and Collective Worship Excellent, Good or Requires Improvement
- 8. Starting point Is this a good school? How convincing is the school that they are better than good. What is the evidence for this? The school must make its own case for excellence there are no grade descriptors.
- 9. The emphasis is on the impact of the vision across the curriculum
- 10.Data will be used but not in the way that Ofsted use it. It will be used to raise questions about the way in which the vision makes an impact on the data.
