



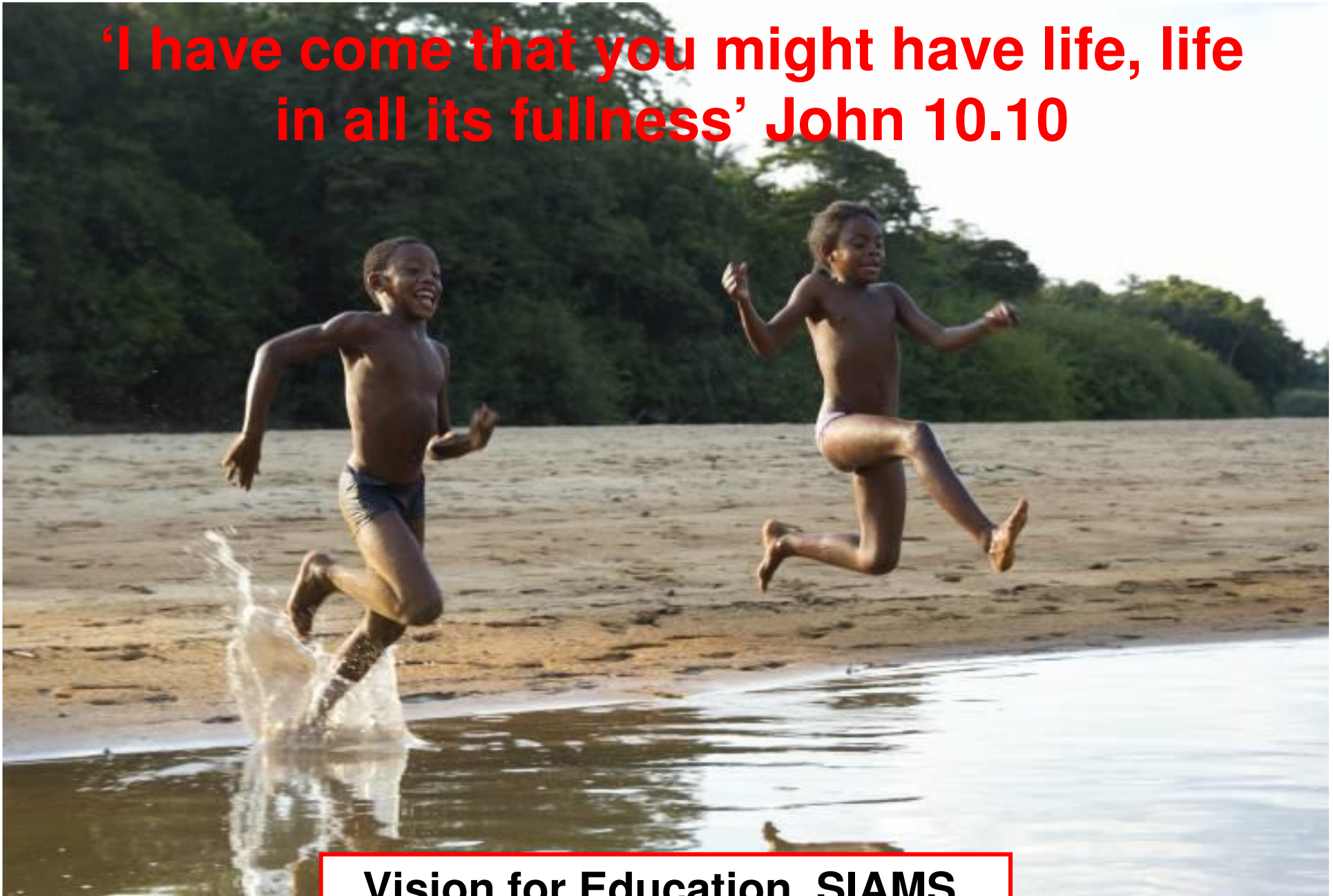

This scheme will:

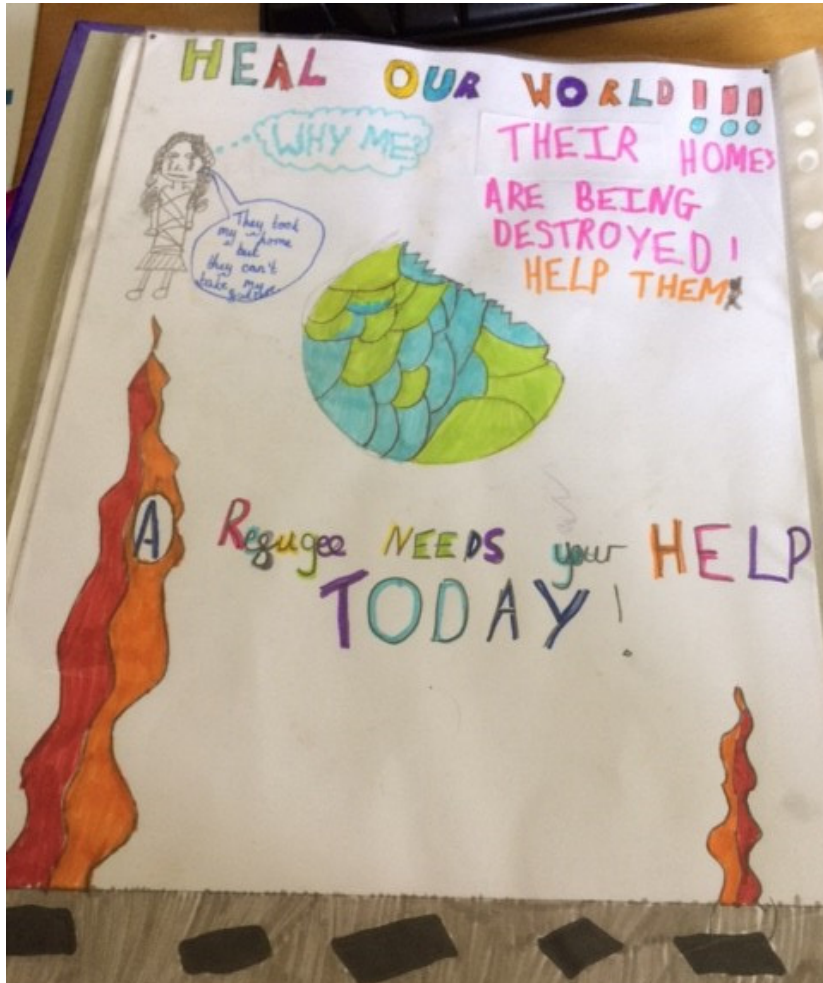
- increase knowledge and understanding about why and how Christians want to change the world to one where everyone can live a full life, free from poverty

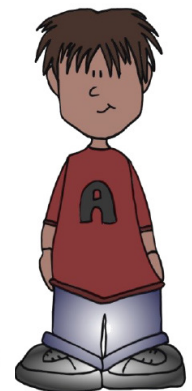


