Grant Info

Thank you to all the wardens and treasurers who have shared with me details of the grants they have received recently. The attached grant funding document is now up to date and I hope churches will find it and the associated links a useful document. I intend to update this on a fairly regular database, so if you are in receipt of grants for your church buildings from other sources, please let me have the details.

Grant Workshop

Applying for grants is often seen as a very difficult and time-consuming process, particularly when you are trying to do it on a voluntary basis alongside many other responsibilities. With this in mind I am planning to arrange a Grant Writing Workshop with support from the team at the cathedral who have vast experience of this process. If you are planning a larger project (not just buildings) at your church in the next year please let me know if this would be of interest to you.

Faculty Workshops

Thank you to those of you who have offered to host a faculty workshop. I am in the process of planning these but could ideally do with one or two venues in the south of the diocese, so if you could host one in that area please let me know. Net-zero carbon report 2021

The 2021 emissions report is <u>now live</u>. The Church of England has seen a gradual but steady reduction in carbon in 2021, according to the latest data from its national Energy Footprint Tool (EFT). Meanwhile, more than 400 churches across England are now reporting 'net zero' carbon emissions, an increase of 157 on the previous year, as part of the most comprehensive data collection to date.
