Durham Diocese Churchwardens Forum

Heating Survey

Over recent months many churches have experienced problems with their heating systems and many churches are also looking at how they can change their heating systems to enable them to reach Net Zero by 2030. At present I am only aware of the heating systems in a small number of churches and in order to offer support it would be really useful to understand more about the types and conditions of heating systems in each church.

Policies

Every church needs to have a range of policies and procedures in place to ensure churches can function effectively. Some policies such as the Safeguarding Policy are provided centrally but other policies need to be written to reflect the needs of individual parishes. Fire Safety

Following the major fire at St John's Wood in London recently, I just wanted to remind you to carry out various checks on your church buildings at the required intervals. These checks include:-

- Electrical Safety Checks
- Gas Safety Checks
- Fire alarm testing and servicing.
- Fire extinguisher servicing
- Lightning Conductor testing
- Ensuring combustible materials are stored correctly.

Please also check your insurance policy to ensure you are aware of any additional checks that are required as part of your policy.

If you feel that you need some professional advice, there are a range of companies who can carry out fire risk assessments. I can send you details of companies that have been used by other churches in the diocese.

Finally if you need any support regarding work on your buildings, please get in touch with me and I will do my best to find you the information that you require.
